

INTRODUCTION

LTA County Cup events are team competitions that take place during February – September each year. Teams from every county in the nation come together for a series of regional and national events to uncover the champions.

There are 7 age groups of competitions for the Junior County Cup – 8U, 9U, 10U, 11U, 12U, 14U and 18U – giving young players a chance to compete with top talent around Britain.

The information which follows outlines the dates and formats (where known) for all the junior County Cups events during 2023, along with the selection process and criteria for each.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible players are those who are LTA members and who satisfy the area qualification rule:

- o Born in Wiltshire
- Lived in Wiltshire for at least six months
- At any time the place of permanent resident has been Wiltshire for a period of five consecutive years
- Not represented another County for at least six months

Players must be of an eligible age as described in the table below to be considered for selection.

SELECTION COMMITTEE & COMMUNICATION OF COUNTY CUP SELECTIONS

Where possible, selections will be made approximately 4 weeks prior to the county cup event. Once selections have been made, Wiltshire Tennis will notify players/parents by email during the following week. The selection committee will consist of the following:

- County Performance Co-ordinators
- Age-group Captains
- o Wiltshire Tennis Management Representative
- County Administrator

AGE GROUPS, COUNTY CUP DATES AND SELECTION CRITERIA

- Only players that are part of the County Training Programme will be eligible for selection for a County Cup event.
- All players are expected to attend the county training camps if they wish to be considered for County Cup unless they are injured or have another tennis commitment at the time of the camp.
- Any player selected for a county training squad in a higher age group (and therefore is effectively playing up)
 will be very much expected to still play and represent the County in their own correct age group should they be
 selected.
- The selection criteria is not listed in any priority order. The Performance Committee will use the following criteria as a basis for selecting each of the following age-group County Cups:
