# **Anti-Doping (Drugs) Policy**

## **Background**

Wiltshire Tennis supports and is bound by the LTA Anti-Doping Regulations which form part of the LTA Disciplinary Code effective 1<sup>st</sup> January 2023.

These apply to players and any support personnel. This includes Volunteers. Where the use of drugs does not fall within the remit of the anti-doping regulations it may constitute misconduct under the LTA Disciplinary Code. Concerns should be reported in accordance with this policy.

## **Wiltshire Tennis Anti-Doping and Drugs Policy**

### **Responsibility**

In particular, each player must know and abide by the Anti-Doping Regulations, policies and practices, and is solely responsible for what they ingest or use.

### **Banned substances**

These are itemised on the Prohibited List updated on 1 January each year by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).

The list includes medications and methods, including social drugs.
